Title: Upham Village Design Statement Supplementary Planning Document.

Subject Matter: The Supplementary Planning Document sets out a framework of guidelines and principals relating primarily to design matters against which future planning applications will be assessed.

Area: The Supplementary Planning Document applies only to the settlements of Upham and Lower Upham (“the village”) and their immediate surroundings. This area is shown in the Map below, and in Map 4 and Appendix 5 of the Supplementary Planning Document. As explained in Appendix 5 of the Supplementary Planning Document, the area follows either the parish boundary or existing field boundaries. This adoption statement refers only to the part of the area within the South Downs National Park as shown in the Map below.

Date of Adoption: 13 March 2025.

Grievances: Any person aggrieved by the Supplementary Planning Document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document. Any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, not later than 3 months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.
